Lamentations seems to be a book of the Bible that is rarely preached from. Its message is serious, while also giving real hope. It brings us face to face with the reality of God's present-tense wrath and raises real questions about how the reality of present-tense wrath relates to believers in our Lord Jesus. Johnny will seek to share the process by which he has wrestled (and continues to wrestle) with Lamentations, with a view to teaching it to others.

Johnny Prime was privileged to serve as pastor at Enfield Evangelical Free Church, North London for 24 years. There he was involved in training assistants and apprentices and in the creation of 'Together for Mission', a partnership of FIEC churches seeking to reach the London Borough of Enfield with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus. From the beginning of 2018 he has been an Associate Director of the FIEC, based in Market Harborough. He has particular responsibility for the overseeing the Pastors' Network of the FIEC. He is a member of Christchurch, Market Harborough. Johnny is married to Sandra and has three grown up daughters and a son-in-law.
