

Module 4:

Biblical Leadership: Bearing the Marks of Jesus in Our Service of the Lord

As Christian servants, we labor to reclaim all things for God's glory. Whether as pastors or youth workers, Bible study teachers or biblical counselors, children's ministry volunteers or outreach directors — we are leaders in the greatest work of all.

Leadership, however, is not easy. Actually, it is dangerous. The devil wants to derail the work of Christ and his favorite strategy is to undermine Christian leaders.

Gratefully by the power of the Holy Spirit, we can resist and triumph. Especially when we follow the principles of godly leadership set out in the Holy Scriptures.

The goal of our course will be to discover and implement what the word of God says about leadership, which will lead inevitably to Christ himself, to the power of cross-shaped leadership.

Together, we will meet in five sessions, beginning either Thursday evening 6th January or Friday morning 7th January, depending which day and time work best for you, with the remaining dates as follows: 20 or 21 January; 17 or 18 February; 3 or 4 March; and 17 or 18 March.

The sessions will last roughly two hours (although the introductory session may be shorter). I will set readings for you from both the Bible and church history, as well as questions to answer, requiring at least four hours in between sessions to complete.
